FIRE RESPONSE PROTOCOL

1. Dialling 111 instigates fire-fighting procedures.
2. The 111 Communication Centre mobilises the nearest Fire Service Brigade or Volunteer Rural Fire Force who respond and commence fire fighting. The forest owner could prompt the Centre by advising which Brigade / Force is closest and the optimal route to take to get to the fire.
3. The Communication Centre also notifies the Rural Fire Authority, in this case Erehwon District Council who are responsible for fire control in the area. They also respond fire-fighting resources if required.
4. The Rural Fire Authority (RFA) should contact the forest owners and inform them that there is a fire in or near the forest. The Rural Fire Authority should involve the owners of the property in the management of the fire whenever practicable. The owner's local knowledge will be invaluable.
5. The (RFA) Principal Rural Fire Officer for Erehwon District Council travels to the fire where he or she takes control of the incident and initiates appropriate action to suppress the fire.
6. The RFA Fire Plan sets out the procedures to manage the incident and identifies fire-fighting resources available within the district.
