

Guidelines for Sand Removal from Castlecliff Beachfront car park

The Wanganui District Council is happy for the public and contractors to remove wind-blown sand on the Castlecliff Beach front car park only. It is situated in front of the fore dune. The park is divided in two, separated by a barrier and the Surf Life Saving Club building.

Under no circumstances is any sand to be removed from the beach area, the beach side of the wall, or dunes behind the car park.

- Any removal is at the expense of the person involved.
- It is expected that courtesy will be given to all people removing sand and to not cause any hindrance to people enjoying the recreation area.
- When removing sand, avoid using heavy vehicles that will damage the car park or beach wall. Do not allow fuel, oil or other wastes to leak from any machinery that is involved in the removal of sand from the Castlecliff Beach car park. If using a back hoe or front end loader which scoops out the sand, the bar on the machinery should be slightly above ground level to avoid damage.
- During summer, removal of sand should be only conducted during low use periods when the beach is not in use by recreation users.
- To ensure the safety of beach users, sand removal contractors must not block the access way of the entry points to the beach from the car park.
